## **Critical Criteria**

- \_\_\_\_ Did not immediately stabilize the extremity manually
- \_\_\_\_ Grossly moves the injured extremity
- \_\_\_\_ Did not immobilize the bone above and below the injury site
- \_\_\_\_ Did not reassess distal motor, sensory, and circulatory functions in the injured extremity before and after splinting
- \_\_\_\_ Failure to manage the patient as a competent EMT
- \_\_\_\_ Exhibits unacceptable affect with patient or other personnel
- \_\_\_\_ Uses or orders a dangerous or inappropriate intervention
